Safety

The Administrative Team of Andrews High School takes all staff and students' safety seriously. Consequently, for the 2024-2025 school year we will be implementing a series of precautionary safety measures such as:

- No backpacks will be allowed in the building.
- All students and visitors will be required to walk through a metal detector upon entering.
- Students will not be allowed to sign in and leave without written or phone confirmation from an authorized parent or guardian.
- Students are required to arrive before 8:00AM for Session 1 and 12:15 pm for Session 2. Students arriving within the documented 30 minutes at the start of each session will be designated as tardy.
- No unapproved late arrivals will be allowed in the building after the tardy period (first 30 minutes).

MENTORING

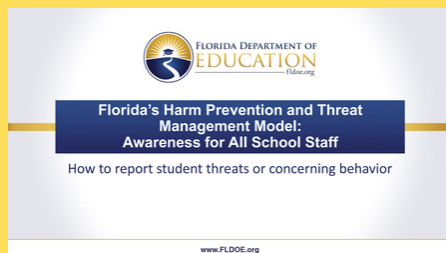

Assessments

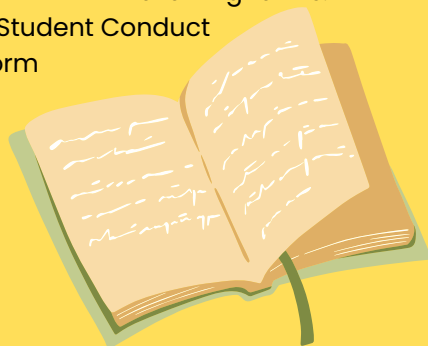
As per the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), according to Florida law, students must meet certain academic requirements to earn a standard high school diploma. This means that students must pass required courses, earn a minimum number of credits, earn a minimum grade point average **and pass the required statewide assessments**. Students who do not meet these requirements will not receive a standard high school diploma.

All students at Andrews High are required to meet the standardized assessment requirements and will need to receive a passing score on the various EOC Assessments and FSA ELA or meet assessment graduation requirement by receiving a concordant/comparative score on the ACT or SAT assessments.
