### Annual Measurable Objectives/School Grade

Andrews High School will continue to follow the FLDOE alternative grading system. Last year our school achieved a rating of **Commendable**.

**Assessments** As per the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), according to Florida law, students must meet certain academic requirements to earn a standard high school diploma. This means that students must pass required courses, earn a minimum number of credits, earn a minimum grade point average **and pass the required statewide assessments**. Students who do not meet these requirements will not receive a standard high school diploma. All students at Andrews High are required to meet the standardized assessment requirements and will need to receive a passing score on the various EOC Assessments and FSA ELA or meet assessment graduation requirement by receiving a concordant/comparative score on the ACT or SAT assessments.



### DIRECT INSTRUCTION

WE WILL PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH DIRECT INSTRUCTION. THIS WILL ALLOW STUDENTS TO CONCENTRATE THEIR EFFORTS ON GAINING PROFICIENCY IN CORE CONTENT AREAS NEEDED TO DEMONSTRATE MASTERY ON STANDARDIZED TESTS AND SUBSEQUENTLY CREATING LIFELONG LEARNERS.
