SAC Meeting Update:

Beginning with the 2026–2027 school year, Florida law requires middle schools to start no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and high schools no earlier than 8:30 a.m. Our school is currently conducting a stakeholder survey to determine how these changes may affect students and families.

To account for the 300 minutes of school and comply with the required minutes per session, our proposed student hours, given the new changes requiring earlier start times, would be:

- High School Session 1: 8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
- High School Session 2: 1:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.

We invite all parents and guardians to complete the stakeholder survey and attend upcoming information meetings at Andrews High School on Friday May 22nd and Tuesday May 26th at 2:00 p.m. Your feedback is important as we evaluate possible schedule adjustments.

Andrews High School will continue to follow the FLDOE alternative grading system. Last year our school achieved a rating of **Commendable**.

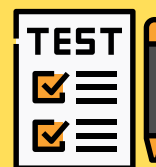
Assessments As per the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), according to Florida law, students must meet certain academic requirements to earn a standard high school diploma. This means that students must pass required courses, earn a minimum number of credits, earn a minimum grade point average **and pass the required statewide assessments**. Students who do not meet these requirements will not receive a standard high school diploma. All students at

Andrews High are required to meet the standardized assessment requirements and will need to receive a passing score on the various EOC Assessments and FSA ELA or meet assessment graduation requirement by receiving a concordant/comparative score on the ACT or SAT assessments.

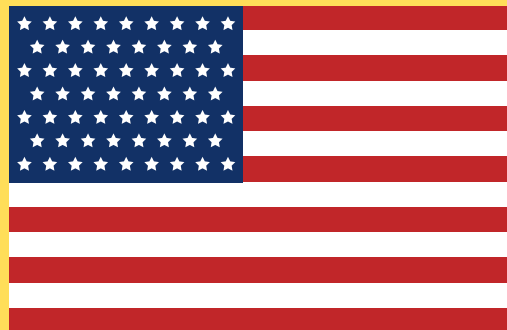
